Introducing Bell's new volunteer initiative

Giving time has never been so simple

Bell is proud to launch a new volunteering initiative to support and recognize team members and retirees who give their time to charitable causes of all kinds.

Part of the Bell Giving Program, the new initiative helps you track your volunteer time in our [online giving tool](#) at bell.benevity.org to reach milestones and earn points toward rewards and recognition. (If this is your first time using the online tool, please email giving@bell.ca to obtain a login and password.)

Track your volunteer time

When you record your volunteer hours in the online giving tool, you will automatically earn points. You can also retroactively input your hours starting from January 1, 2019.

Track your hours when volunteering for:

- Charities or non-profits
- Community-based activities for schools, sports organizations, local events
- Fundraising events and causes
- Activities where you apply your professional skills at no charge

Participating in charitable events such as cycling, running or walking for a cause are not eligible for tracking in the online giving tool.

Apply for a team grant

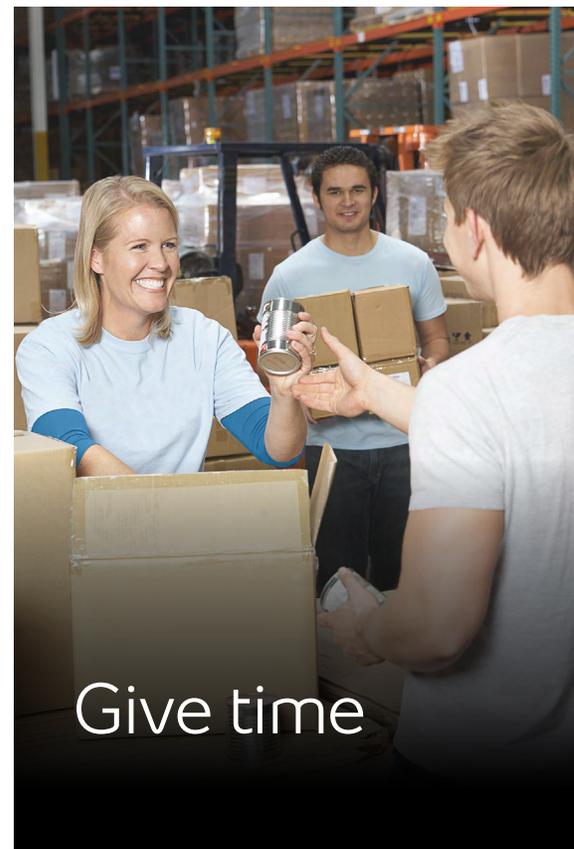
Bell is offering team grants of \$250 to support registered Canadian charities. To be eligible to apply, your volunteer team must have 3 or more Bell employees and/or retirees who have volunteered 30 combined hours, outside of work hours, for the same activity or organization.

To apply, complete the [online application](#) at grantstream.com/Bell/form/Volunteer/en/. Before you submit it, please ensure all employee and retiree team members have tracked their volunteer hours in the online giving tool.

Teams who volunteer for a non-registered charity, can submit a grant application and will need to name the registered Canadian charity designated as the grant recipient. For example, if your team volunteered for a youth hockey organization, you could apply and direct the grant to the Hockey Canada Foundation.

Individuals are eligible to be part of 3 team grants per calendar year. Eligibility is based on a team member or retiree being part of Bell's SAP payroll system.
